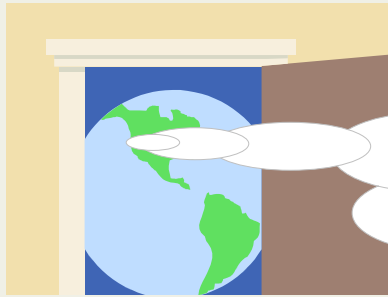


Mental Health Resource Forums

Due to the economic downturn and the financial structure by which local County mental health services are funded, the greatest impact will be felt by the adult mental health consumers served in our community outpatient system.

Sacramento County Department of Behavioral Health, Mental Health Division, is still working hard to develop alternative to program losses. We do not know what decisions will be made and may not have final program impacts until later this summer. However, the county wants to share available information about system changes and help develop community alternatives to your care.
